Cornelia	P.O. 1894-1902, Harrison Twp
Diamond Grove	Beetown Twp, on Muscalunge Road West of Beetown
Dutch Hollow	became Tennyson, Potosi Twp
Ebenzer	Wingville Twp
Edwardsville	P.O. 1844-47, became Beetown, Beetown Twp
Elmdale	P.O. 1881-1887, Waterloo Twp
Elmo	P.O. 1875-1907, Smelser Twp
English Prairie	P.O. 1838-1842, became Muscoda, Muscoda Twp
Fair Play	P.O. 1841-1895, Fairplay 1895-1907, Jamestown Twp
Fairview	P.O. 1861-1881, 1868 map in Hazel Green Twp
Flora Fountain	P.O. 1891-1901, also know as Slabtown, Beetown Twp
Gibraltar	P.O. in 1838, South of Paris, Northwest of Dickeyville, Paris Twp
Gilmore	Hazel Green Twp, near Sinsinawa Mound
Grantville	Potosi Twp, where Grant River flows into Mississippi, probably where LaFayette was later
Green Cloud Hill	Ghost Town, named after Indian Chief, where Wyalusing State Park is now
Hackett	Beetown Twp
Happy Corners	Smelser Twp
Hard Town	became Fairplay, Jamestown Twp
Hardy's Scrap	became Hard Scrabble which became Hazel Green
Hazelton	Wyalusing Twp
Hermitage	became Mt Hope, Mt Hope Twp
Homer	P.O. 1857-1901, Hickory Grove Twp

Hurricane Grove	became Hurricane 1883, South Lancaster Twp
Jamestown	P.O. 1837-1903, North of Louisburg, Jamestown Twp
Jefferson	became Lewisburg, North of Hazel Green, Hazel Green Twp
Jimtown	also known as Louisburg, Jamestown Twp
Kaysville	became Big Patch, Smelser Twp
King's Ford	by Platte River, Ellenboro Twp
Klondyke	North of Lancaster
LaFayette	Potosi Twp, by Grant River, Canal cut through to Mississippi River on 1868, 1877 & 1895 maps
Liberty Ridge	P.O. 1869-1903, Liberty Twp
Little Grant	P.O. 1852-1887, Little Grant Twp
Loafer's Retreat	Wyalusing Twp
Louisburgh	named changed to Louisburg, Jamestown Twp
Martinville	P.O. 1859-1886, bu Rock Cem West of Livingston, Clifton Twp
McCartney Station	P.O. in 1896, Waterloo Twp
Menomonee	P.O. 1838, became Kieler, Jamestown Twp
Millville	P.O. in 1852, Millville Twp
Muscalunge	Beetown Twp, West of Beetown
New California	P.O. 1850-1875, Clifton Twp
Nip & Tuck	Church & Cem in Lima Twp, South of Arthur, also called Lida
Oliver's Mill	P.O. 1858-1864, became North Andover, Glen Haven Twp
Ora Oak	P.O. 1856-1875, became Hazeltown, Wyalusing Twp
Osceola	Potosi Twp
Paper City	Ghost Town, Wyalusing Twp
Paris	Paris Twp, two miles Northwest of Dickeyville along Little Platte River
Pidgeon	South Lancaster Twp
Powder Mills	Platteville Twp, West of Platteville along Little Platte River
Preston	on township line of Fennimore & Wingville Twp
Puckerville	became Louisburg, Jamestown Twp
Rockville	Potosi Twp
Rosendale	Woodman Twp
Saint Rose	Smelser Twp, North of Cuba City
Sinipee	P.O. 1838-1841, James Twp, along Mississippi River
Sinsinawa Mound	P.O. started 1839, became Sinsinawa 1883, Hazel Green Twp
Smeltzer's Grove	became Georgetown 1870, Smelser Twp
Snake Hollow	became Potosi, Potosi Twp
Stumptown	also Ray's Landing, became Glen Haven, Glen Haven Twp
Tafton	became Bloomington 1867, Bloomington Twp
Toadville	Platteville Twp
Union	Lima Twp
Ursine	became Patch Grove 1852, Patch Grove Twp
Van Buren	Potosi Twp, part of Potosi now
Washburne	P.O. 1855-1883, became Arthur, Lima Twp
