POLK COUNTY TAX RECORDS

The original tax receipts (public records) can be found at the Polk County Historical Society museum in Balsam Lake, Wisconsin. Some of the records are for taxes paid on personal property (moveable property) and some are for real estate (land) taxes. I have not listed the amount of the tax nor have I listed the justification for the tax. (These records are well over a hundred years old and very difficult to read.
